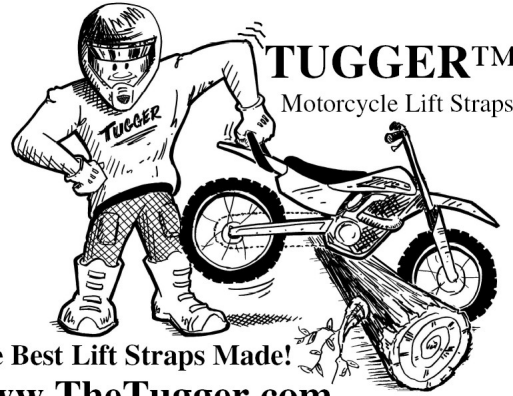

The event pre-registration fee for adults is \$42.00, and children 12 yrs. & younger is \$25.00. If you choose not to pre-register, the event fee for adults is \$50.00 and children 12 yrs. & younger will be \$35.00 during designated registration hours. The registration fee covers one, two and/or three days. The event will be rain or shine and the registration fee is nonrefundable. Rain generally improves the trails at Loretta's and water drains off quickly.

Pre-registration forms and payment must be postmarked on or before March 15, 2012. Failure to meet this deadline may result in the having to pay the standard event registration fee. All pre-registered riders will still need to come to registration during designated registration hours to sign release forms and pick up your wristbands.

Designated registration times are:

Thursday March 29 - 5:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

Friday March 30th - 7:30 a.m. to 10:30 a.m.

Saturday March 31st - 7:30 a.m. to 10:30 a.m.

Sunday April 1st - 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m.

There will be a MANDATORY rider meeting on Friday March 30th, Saturday March 31st, and April 1st at 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. All riders must attend one meeting each day before riding on the trail. The trailhead opens both days at 9:00 a.m. and closes at 3:00 p.m.

Pit Riding and/or Pit Bikes/ATV PIT RIDING Will Not Be Tolerated!

The Trail:

The trail will be clearly marked and you can ride it at your own pace as much as you like during the open trail hours. There will be riding opportunities for all from beginner to advanced.

The trail lengths and locations will be announced at each of the rider meetings. The main trail's difficulty level will be moderate. Some of the hill-climbs are tough, and occasionally the trail may be narrow and/or off-camber. Some of the areas are rocky and other areas are normal dirt. There's usually little or no mud, even after a rain. There will be a kid's loop (easy), novice loop (intermediate), and main trail (advanced) sections.

Camp Ground Information:

Camping is \$27.50 per site per night per family up to two vehicles. Sharing of the campsite will entail an additional \$27.50 per living quarters (i.e. tents, trailers and motor homes). Any additional vehicles are \$5.00 each. If you park in a campsite, expect to pay camping. Please stop at the camping registration office when you arrive. If the office is closed when you arrive, please settle up with them first thing the next day. Camping will be permitted in the upper and lower campground.

Free Day Parking is only allowed in the designated day parking area. If you choose to day park elsewhere in the campground expect to pay \$5.00 per vehicle.

The campground has two nice bathhouses and a camp store that carries a little bit of everything from groceries to camping supplies. Loretta Lynn's will offer breakfast and lunch concessions at reasonable prices.

Banquet:

There will be a catered banquet on Saturday evening under the big pavilion, beginning at 6:00pm. Cost will be \$12.00 per person, with tickets being sold during registration hours. Lots of prizes will be given away during the banquet, so you should be sure to join us for a fun filled evening. Our sincere thanks to the following banquet sponsors:

Directions:

About 60 miles west of Nashville, TN on I- 40 take the Linden/Waverly exit 143. Turn North on Highway 13 toward Waverly for 7 miles and turn left into the ranch entrance. Overnight campers please stop at campground registration, which is immediately on your left. There you can pay for camping and be directed to the appropriate area. Day parkers will proceed straight to the day parking area.

MTDR would like to thank Loretta Lynn's Ranch for this great opportunity and has plans to make the event unforgettable and enjoyable weekend of riding.

MTDR's Spring Dirt Bike Ride Rules:

1. MTDR makes the rules and all rules are subject to change.
2. Each rider must register in person regardless of age where he or she shall receive his or her own wristband. This wristband must be worn at all times and cannot be shared with fellow riders. If you lose your wristband, you must reregister at the full fee during registration hours. A parent/ legal guardian must accompany riders under the age of 18.
3. Attending a riders meeting each day is mandatory – **NO EXCEPTIONS**
4. Helmet, boots, gloves and eye protection must be worn at all times during riding.
5. An adult must accompany all riders riding under the age of 16 at all times - **NO EXCEPTIONS**
6. **No Pit Riding or Pit Bikes/ATV Allowed-** Speed Limit in the campground is 5 mph
7. No Buddy Rides - NO EXCEPTIONS
8. **THIS IS NOT A RACE, PASS WITH CARE** - Riders caught in the act of riding dangerously and/or not courteous to fellow riders will have their riding privileges revoked and no refund will be given
9. Ride on designated trails only. Do not venture off the marked trails.
10. Riding alone is considered unsafe.
11. There is a designated road crossing between the upper and lower campgrounds. All bikes and ATV's MUST cross at this crossing at all times. No exceptions. Riders crossing elsewhere, or riding on the road, are subject to losing their wristband without a refund.
12. Alcohol and riding don't mix, so don't do it. Offenders will NOT be tolerated. Alcohol is permitted after your ride is over as long as you **act responsibly**.
13. The motocross track is strictly off-limits. Don't even think about it.
14. Quiet hours in the campground are from 10:30 p.m. to 6:30 a.m. NO TOLERANCE. Please be courteous to your fellow campers.
15. Do not trash the bathhouses. These are for bathing not washing your clothes and boots. There is a laundry room for dirty clothes behind the recreation room at the Camp Store.
16. Fires are permitted only in designated fire rings. Do not leave your fires unattended and trash burning is considered unlawful. **Do NOT move fire rings!** You can NOT build a fire ring! Violation of this ranch policy will result in expulsion from the premises and forfeiture of all riding and camping fees. Do not risk our future rides here by not adhering to this policy.
17. Pressure washers and bike washing are not permitted on the grounds of Loretta Lynn's Ranch at any time.
18. Anyone camping or parking in a designated camping spot that refuses to pay the camping fee to Loretta's Lynn's Ranch will be forced to leave the premises and no ride fee refund will be given. Failure to pay may also win you a visit by Humphrey's County Sheriff's Department.
19. Anyone caught in the act of deliberate destruction or theft of anyone's personal property or Loretta Lynn's Ranch property, will be turned over to the Humphrey's County Sheriff Department.
20. Pack it in, pack it out. Do not leave trash behind. Please place all trash in designated containers and police your areas for trash before leaving the ranch.
21. If you use straw or hay for wet ground conditions, you must remove it before your departure.
22. **No loud exhaust pipes. Sound testing will be performed this year. Sound level must be below 98dB SPL. Sound testing will be open during all registration hours.**

MINOR RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT
(READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING)

MTDR Loretta Lynn's Spring Trail Ride

NAME OF TRACK AND/OR EVENT

EVENT DATE(S)

IN CONSIDERATION of allowing the below MINOR participant to compete, officiate, observe, work for, or participate ("participate") in any way in the above event and/or activities ("EVENT(S)") and/or being permitted to enter for any purpose any RESTRICTED AREA (defined as any area requiring special authorization, credentials or permission to enter or any area to which admission by the general public is restricted or prohibited, including but not limited to the competition area and any hot pit or paddock area), EACH OF THE UNDERSIGNED, for himself/herself, his/her personal representatives, heirs, and next of kin agrees that:

7. THE MINOR AND PARENT OR GUARDIAN will immediately inspect the RESTRICTED AREA upon entering it and warrants that their entry therein and/or the MINOR'S Event participation constitutes an acknowledgement that they have inspected the RESTRICTED AREA and find it safe and reasonably suited for the purpose of its use. The undersigned agree that if at any time in the RESTRICTED AREA they believe something to be unsafe, it will be brought to the attention of an official, and they will remove themselves from the RESTRICTED AREA and the MINOR will withdraw from participation in the Event.
8. THE MINOR AND PARENT OR GUARDIAN HEREBY ASSUME FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE RISK OF BODILY INJURY, DEATH OR PROPERTY DAMAGE due to negligence of Releasees (as identified below) or otherwise, while in or upon the RESTRICTED AREA for any purpose and/or while participating in any way in the Event. The undersigned recognize and understand that there are risks and dangers associated with participation in the Event and admission within the RESTRICTED AREA that could cause severe bodily injury, disability, and death. Further, the risks and dangers may be caused by the negligent failure to act of the Releasees and others. All of the risks and dangers associated with participating in the Event and/or entry into the RESTRICTED AREA are assumed notwithstanding.
9. THE MINOR AND PARENT OR GUARDIAN release, waive, discharge, and covenant not to sue the promoters, participants, racing associations, sanctioning or administrative organizations or any affiliated entities thereof, track operators, track owners, officials, car owners, drivers, pit crews, all persons in any RESTRICTED AREA, sponsors, advertisers, owners, lessors and lessees of premises used to conduct the Event, premises and event inspectors, surveyors, underwriters, brokers, consultants and others who give recommendations, directions, or instructions, or engage in risk evaluation or loss control activities regarding the premises or EVENT(S) and for each of them, their directors, officers, agents, and employees (all for the purposes herein referred to as ("Releasees")), from all liability to ourselves, the undersigned, our personal representatives, assigns, executors, heirs, and next of kin, for any and all claims, demands, losses or damages of the MINOR and/or parent or guardian on account of any injury, including, but not limited to the death or injury of the parent/guardian or MINOR or damage to property, all of which is caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise.
10. THE PARENT AND/OR GUARDIAN hereby agrees to indemnify and save and hold harmless, the Releasees and each of them from any loss, liability, damage, or cost they may occur due, in any manner or degree, to the presence of the parent/ guardian or the MINOR in the RESTRICTED AREA, or related in any way to their participation in or presence at the Event and whether caused by negligence of the Releasees or otherwise. The parent and/or guardian further recognize and agree they are executing this Waiver and Release of Liability and Indemnity Agreement on behalf of themselves and on behalf of the MINOR.
11. This release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement extends to all acts of negligence by the Releasees, INCLUDING NEGLIGENT RESCUE OPERATIONS and is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the laws of the Province or State in which the Event(s) is/are conducted and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.

THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN HAS READ AND VOLUNTARILY SIGNS THE WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT AND DOES SO VOLUNTARILY AND WITH THE UNDERSTANDING THAT SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS ARE BEING GIVEN UP. I/ WE FURTHER ACKNOWLEDGE THAT FAILURE TO WITNESS OR NOTARIZE THIS AGREEMENT SHALL NOT AFFECT ITS VALIDITY.
